

WDCA Student Scholarship Application

Definition:

Each year, the WDCA shall bestow upon three worthy recipients a post-secondary scholarship award.

Requirements:

1. Three year involvement in Policy, Lincoln Douglas, and/or Public Forum debate.
2. Overall grade-point average of 2.75 or better based upon an **official transcript**.

Selection Weighing:

1. Quality performance in debate
2. Involvement in other school and community activities
3. Recommendations and personal essay demonstrating leadership, character, and integrity

A completed application includes the following:

1. An official school transcript
2. A letter of recommendation from your coach
3. A letter of recommendation from another person, not related to you, such as a guidance counselor or teacher.
4. A personal statement reflecting on your experiences as a debater, especially successes you have had, other extra-curricular and volunteer activities, leadership situations, and how you feel your participation in debate will help you in your future endeavors. This statement can be typed or handwritten.

The application deadline is Tuesday January 9th, 2018.
